## Replacement of RT0085 Diagnostic Kit with Rinda Diacom P/N RT0086

PCM made available an inexpensive diagnostic kit for MEFI 4 systems earlier this year. This was an attempt at providing an inexpensive way to communicate with the MEFI 4 ECM. Since the release of this diagnostic kit, RT0085, some copyright issues have been raised. Because of these copyright issues, it has been decided that the RT0085 Diagnostic Kit will no longer be available.

A new software package will soon be offered in the place of the RT0085. The new software is Diacom, made by Rinda Technologies. The Diacom package offers many advantages over the RT0085. Some of the features include:

- Communicates with MEFI 1, MEFI 2, MEFI 3, MEFI 4 and MEFI 4B
- Capabilities of incorporating service manual information into the program
- Capable of performing "field" calibration downloads without replacing the ECM
