Dear Pleasurecraft Engine Owner:

This letter is to inform you that a possible safety related condition is present in your PCM engine. This condition involves the electrical system, which could, under certain circumstances, cause a **fire and/or explosion** resulting in **personal injury or death.** Although there have been <u>no</u> reported cases of **fire or explosion**, in the interest of your safety, PCM strongly recommends that the boat not be used until the necessary modifications are made to eliminate the possible unsafe condition. The modification requires the replacement of the positive (+) and negative (-) wires of the alternator circuit and repositioning of the wires on the circuit breaker.

Please contact your selling dealer as soon as possible so he may arrange for this condition to be corrected. The modification is relatively simple and should be completed within a relatively short time. This repair will be made at your dealer's location at no cost to you for parts or labor.

We have also observed a limited number of durability issues regarding the electrical/charging system on the engine model(s) you purchased. As a result, we have developed enhancements which insure the type of durability we constantly strive for. The product enhancements are easily made, and will be made at the same time the safety condition is corrected, all at no charge to you. We believe this safety recall and the product durability enhancements are necessary to insure you have the safest and most trouble-free boating experience possible.
